Today your Negotiating Team had its fourth session of Negotiations with the Company. Robust discussions continued around multiple provisions of Article 8. As this item dramatically impacts daily operational procedures of the company, and therefore the conditions to which we are continuously subject as pilots, great care and diligence was put forward to craft policies which will benefit both the company and our membership.

Once again, things went very smoothly, strengthening the spirit of open debate and good faith negotiations that has been previously established. We have tentatively agreed to much improved language in Article 8, providing for what we believe will offer significant benefit to the members as a whole. Potential problems were exposed and addressed in a manner that we expect to result in improved clarity and understanding for both sides going forward.

Discussions ended today with an introduction to certain concerns in Article 11 regarding LOAs.

As we continue to work hard to provide you with the best Contract possible, we are optimistic that proceedings can now gain momentum.
